



Kids Japanese Side Sewn Book *with* Jody Alexander

This is a wonderful folding structure for kids and adults alike. Kids can draw their own house - inside and out - on the finished book, and write a story about their home. If you make this with more sophisticated materials, this folding technique can be used for a dynamic artists' book.



Materials

- Straight edge ruler
- Hole punch
- Cutting knife (optional if tearing paper)
- One 8.5 x 11 cover paper (will be halved to make two cover pieces)
- 5 sheets of text weight or lightweight paper
- Heavy or stiff craft string or cord
- Pre-cut paper for kids

What You'll Learn

- Preparing pages
- Punching hole
- Japanese binding
